



SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STEM AND HEALTH CARE MAJORS

WSOS builds pathways into high-demand Washington careers for Washington students.

Our Baccalaureate Scholarship provides up to \$22,500 in financial aid and access to support services for students pursuing science, technology, engineering, math (STEM) and health care majors that will lead to high-demand careers. This scholarship can be used to cover tuition, fees and other indirect costs of attendance such as housing, transportation, food and more.

Funding can be used for any eligible STEM or health care degree at any eligible public or private college or university in Washington state.

WHY WSOS?

Washington has one of the fastest growing state economies with more trade, health care and STEM jobs than we can fill. The Washington State Opportunity Scholarship aims to connect our state's leading industries with top Washington talent by reducing barriers to education and training. Working collaboratively with the state and industry partners, we launch low- and middle-income students into careers, maximizing the state's return on investment and ensuring Washington's robust economy can continue to thrive.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must meet all of the following eligibility criteria.

Enrollment Plan

- Plan to pursue an eligible science, technology, engineering, math or health care major.
- Plan to enroll at an eligible Washington state college or university in the fall of 2025.

Residency

- Be a Washington state resident. Visit our [website](#) for more information.

Academic Record

- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 at time of application.
- Earn a high school diploma or GED from a Washington state high school or institution by June 2025.

Previous Education Experience

- Have not yet earned a bachelor's degree.
- Applicant must currently be a:
 - High school senior;
 - Have earned their high school credential; or a
 - College freshman or college sophomore. If the applicant has completed any college terms or college credits post high-school, they must meet either the maximum term OR maximum credit requirement stated below.
 - The applicant must have completed no more than six quarters or four semesters of college at the end of the current academic year; OR the applicant must have earned no more than 90 quarter or 60 semester credits at the end of the current academic year.
 - College credits earned while in high school do not count towards your eligibility!

Financial Need

- Complete the FAFSA or WASFA by **February, 2025**.
- Have a total family income that does not exceed 125% of Washington state median family income. Use these numbers as an approximation, as they may change slightly before the application opens.
