GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

The **Graduate Scholarship** (GRD) is one of three pathways to high-demand careers in Washington state offered by **Washington State Opportunity Scholarship** (WSOS).

This program aims to increase the number of nurse practitioners providing health care in medically underserved areas of the state.

GRD requires Scholars to complete at least 50% of their clinical practicum hours in an HRSA-designated Medically Underserved Area (MUA) or Health Professional Shortage Area (HPSA).

We understand there are costs associated with hosting a student for practicums. To mitigate these costs, **WSOS offers \$30 per clinical hour to sites located in an MUA or HPSA that host a GRD Scholar**. A minimum of 60 clinical hours is required to access the stipend. For example, if a site hosts a GRD Scholar for 120 clinical hours, it is eligible for a \$3,600 stipend.

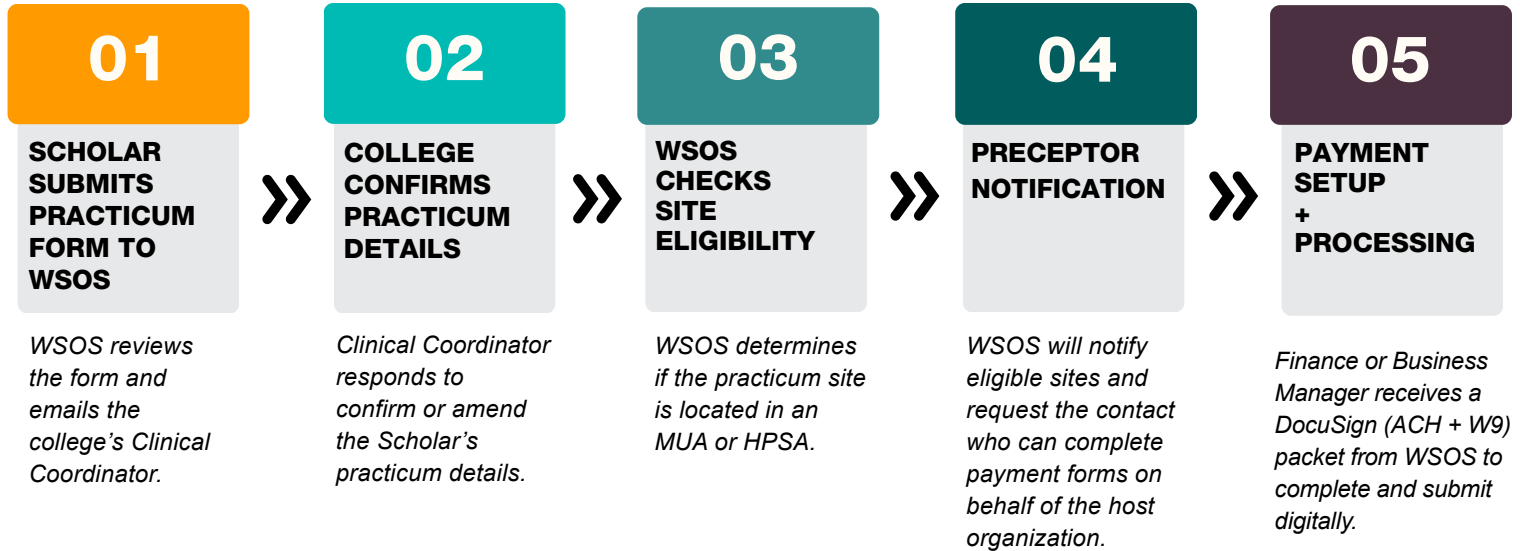

Stipends are distributed to the organization (not individuals). Sites may use funds in any way that supports their work. Stipends are considered a donation in support of training DNP and MSN students, not payment for services.



Please note: Payment can only begin once the Scholar has completed more than 75% of practicum hours.
